ORDER

WHEREAS the Court receives approximately 300 Notices of Appeal every month, as well as numerous motions and other filings, and

WHEREAS appeals, motions, and other filings with the Court deserve timely judicial review and decision, and

WHEREAS the Chief Judge of the Court pursuant to 38 U.S.C. §7257 (b)(1) may recall Senior Judges of the Court who have retired but who have agreed to be available for such recall when their service is needed by the Court, and

WHEREAS the Chief Judge of the Court has determined that the service of two Senior Judges is needed by the Court and, if recalled, they would perform substantial service to the Court by reviewing and deciding appeals, motions, and other filings with the Court, and

WHEREAS Senior Judges John J. Farley, III, and Donald L. Ivers have agreed to be available for recall as needed by the Court,

THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED that, effective on or about September 13, 2010, Senior Judges John J. Farley, III, and Donald L. Ivers are recalled from retired status to have and to exercise all of the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service and otherwise perform substantial service in reviewing and deciding appeals, motions, and other filings with the Court, until the Chief Judge of the Court determines their service is no longer needed or 90 days, whichever is sooner, unless extended by the Chief Judge with the consent of the Senior Judges.
