## ORDER

WHEREAS the Chief Judge of the Court, pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), may recall Senior Judges of the Court who have retired but who have agreed to be available for such recall when their service is needed by the Court, and

WHEREAS the Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Senior Judge William P. Greene, Jr., would provide substantial service necessary to meet the needs of the Court, and

WHEREAS Senior Judge Greene has consented to be available for recall as needed by the Court,

THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED that, effective June 16, 2015, Judge William P. Greene, Jr., is recalled from retired status to have and to exercise all of the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service and to otherwise perform substantial service with the Court as requested by the Chief Judge. Judge Greene shall serve until the Chief Judge of the Court determines that his service is no longer needed or until June 30, 2015, whichever is sooner. Each day of service shall be recorded and maintained by the Clerk of the Court.
