## ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), eligible retired Judges of the Court may be recalled by the Chief Judge when further service is needed by the Court. Retired Judge Robert N. Davis, having complied with 38 U.S.C. § 7257, is designated a recall-eligible retired Judge. The Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Judge Davis would provide substantial service necessary to meet the needs of the Court.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective January 12, 2022, for a 30-day period ending February 11, 2022, recall-eligible retired Judge Davis is recalled from retired status in accordance with 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1). Judge Davis shall have and exercise all the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service and shall otherwise perform substantial service for the Court as requested by the Chief Judge. It is further

ORDERED that Judge Davis shall serve in recalled status during this 30-day period to review and decide appeals, motions, and other filings with the Court related to cases originally assigned to him during his recall service last concluded on December 31, 2021. If necessary, and with his consent, Judge Davis's service may be extended for up to 90 days.
