ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), and in order to meet the needs of the Court, eligible retired judges may be recalled by the Chief Judge to perform substantial service. Retired Judge Lawrence B. Hagel, having complied with 38 U.S.C. § 7257, is designated a recall-eligible retired judge. The Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Judge Hagel would provide substantial service by completing matters that were assigned to him prior to his retirement.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective October 13, 2016, Judge Lawrence B. Hagel is recalled from retired status in accordance with 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1). When in service, Judge Hagel shall have and exercise all of the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service. Judge Hagel shall perform substantial service for the Court intermittently through the end of this calendar year in accordance with this order and as requested by the Chief Judge.
