ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), eligible retired Judges of the Court may be recalled by the Chief Judge when further service is needed by the Court. Retired Judge Lawrence B. Hagel, having complied with 38 U.S.C. § 7257, is designated a recall-eligible retired Judge. The Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Judge Hagel would provide substantial service necessary to meet the needs of the Court.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, as of the date of this order, recall-eligible retired Judge Hagel is recalled from retired status in accordance with 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1) as a panel member for an attorney discipline case on which he previously served. Judge Hagel shall have and exercise all the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service and shall otherwise perform substantial service for the Court as requested by the Chief Judge. Judge Hagel shall serve until the action on the attorney discipline case is completed, or until October 31, 2017, whichever is soonest.
